Peaks: Home Mountain (8870ft/2704m), Jones Hole (8380ft/2554m), Zenobia Peak (9006ft/2745m), Roundtop (8575ft/2614m), Tanks Peak (8717ft/2657m), Allred Peak (7679ft/2393m).

Rivers: Green River, Yampa River.

Other landmarks: Gates of Lodore, Harpers Corner, Harpers Corner Drive, Escalante Overlook, Plug Hat Butte, Wagon Wheel Point Overlook, Baker Cabin, Castle Park, Castle Park Overlook, Harding Hole Overlook, Starvation Valley, Five Spring Draw, Haystack Rock, Deerlodge Park (no water).
