Entering St. Albans on Route 152 from Hartland, turn right at the blinking light, Corinna Road Route 43 and proceed approximately 4.1 miles, turn left onto Ham Road which is across from Nokomis Road, cemetery is a short distance on the left. The oldest stone is that of Miriam LYFORD who died in 1813.
