

08 - Stewart Cemetery

Circa 1832

St. Albans, Somerset County, Maine

Coming into Hartland on Route 152 at the intersection of Route 151, turn left on Commercial Street. Continue to the corner of Pond Road, cemetery on left. Entire graveyard was covered (and hidden) by Sumac bushes for many years. This cemetery was cleared by Ron Fowle Jr. for his Eagle Scout Project in mid 1990 and has been kept up very nicely. Oldest stone is from 1832 and there are three of them, Abigail STEWART, Orrin STEWART and Emeline WILSON.
