Erie Man Killed In Farm Accident

Lawrence P. Henderson, 71, who farmed with his sons at Erie, N.D., died in a farm accident at his home Wednesday afternoon, December 18, 1974.

It was reported to The Forum that Mr. Henderson was operating a hay chopper in his farmyard when he was caught by a power take-off on a tractor. He was found about 3:30 p.m. by his sons who were working nearby, but did not witness the accident. He was dead at the scene.

Mr. Henderson was born at Clifford, N.D., April 7, 1903, and married Jean Priewe Dec. 4, 1925. The couple farmed after their marriage and he also served as a 4-H leader and on his church board.
